Build a School

Good Shepherd Academy is designed by MSAADA Architects, a non-profit architectural firm with offices in the USA, Africa, India, and Haiti. With over 30 years' experience, MSAADA and founding architect Poul Bertelsen have completed over 800 schools, hospitals, and churches in 40 developing nations. MSAADA'S unique experience and proven track record make them the ideal choice to design and supervise the construction of Good Shepherd Academy.



Sage Construction of Bamenda, Cameroon is constructing Phase I. They have hired over 60 Cameroonians to build the Academy, providing much needed jobs to local craftsmen. In addition, over 40 local women have helped in planning and planting the sustainable farms.

Sustainable organic chicken, fish, pig, and vegetable farms will be one of the means of self-sufficiency integral to the GSA community. They will also have an important educational value, serving as outdoor classrooms.

Phase 1 construction is on time/on budget — an amazing feat, but business as usual for MSAADA Architects!
